A contact lens is more than a commodity; it is a medical device that requires professional evaluation, fitting and follow-up to prevent serious ocular damage and vision loss.

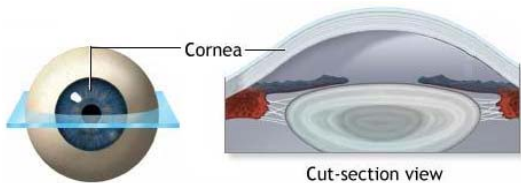

- Determination of proper contact lens parameters
- Fitting of the contact lens
- Microscope analysis with diagnostic lenses on
- Evaluation of contact lens fit, movement, centration & rotation
- Over-refraction with diagnostic lenses
- Visual acuity with diagnostic lenses

Education

- Contact lens related medical concerns
- Proper contact lens wear & care
- Proper wearing time & replacement schedule
- Proper cleaning procedures & solution
- Proper follow up schedule
- Contact Lens Insertion & Removal Training (for 1st time wearers)

During your evaluation and/or fitting you will also receive

- Diagnostic contact lenses (Excludes RGPs & “daily wear” contacts)
- Contact lens care solution (2 FL OZ) and case
- A signed contact lens prescription upon finalization of the contact lens fitting process.

Contact Lens Evaluation

All contact lens wearers must undergo an annual contact lens evaluation to monitor corneal health and to obtain an updated contact lens prescription. A contact lens evaluation includes all of the above elements.

Contact Lens Fitting

A contact lens fitting is the process in which a patient undergoes a contact lens evaluation AND requires additional follow up care because of complexity of a new prescription, material or fitting style.
